Cradle to career and families

- Kids Thrive Birth to five years
  - Reducing average NICU length of stay for newborns born substance exposed
- Charlotte County Reads Kindergarten to third grade
  - o 20,021 books read COVID-19 summer 80% no reading loss
- Ending Youth & Chronic Homelessness
  - Effectively ended chronic homelessness in December 2020
- (VITA) Volunteer Income Tax Assistance
  - o \$1,054,974 Total Economic Impact in Charlotte County
- Season of Sharing
  - \$571,852 helped 800 families (2,196 people) with rent, mortgage, and utilities last year 100% of these funds go to families
